

Sullivan County, Tennessee, hereby provides public notice of its intent to apply for grant funding through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), administered in Tennessee by the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency.

Sullivan County is seeking funding to purchase and install permanent standby generators at critical county facilities, including the Emergency Management Agency (EMA) and Finance Department. These facilities currently lack permanent backup power and are vulnerable to extended outages caused by severe weather events such as windstorms, ice storms, and flooding

The purpose of this project is to ensure continuity of essential government operations during and after disaster events. The installation of generators will allow emergency coordination, communications, financial operations, and other critical services to remain operational during utility failures, thereby protecting public health and safety for approximately 160,000 county residents.
